



#### Behind Gender Based Violence

## Domestic violence

- Europe: 66% of victims were attacked by a person who had used alcohol
- UK: Alcohol is involved in 88% of cases involving dual perpetration of violence and 55% of sole perpetrator cases
- Argentina: 68% of cases are alcohol related
- Rwanda: FGD in rural areas rank alcohol #1 cause



## Behind Gender Based Violence

## Intimate partner violence

- Africa, Asia: ca. 65% of women experiencing IPV in South Africa, India, Uganda, Vietnam, Zimbabwe report alcohol use by perpetrator
- Brazil: 70% of cases alcohol related
- USA: 50% of cases involve alcohol
- Australia: 44% of intimate partner homicide cases associated with alcohol



## Behind Gender Based Violence

## Children: victims and witnesses

- Europe: 16% of cases of CAN involve alcohol
- Australia: ca. 34% (1 million) of children live in households with at least one addict
- USA: mothers convicted of child abuse 3x, fathers 10x more likely to be alcoholics. Ca 26 million CoA



## Behind Gender Based Violence

## Children: victims and witnesses

- USA: >50% of all abuse reports involve the use of alcohol.
- Europe: At least 9 million children grow up with alcohol-addicted parents



Behind Gender Based Violence

# Alcohol is present

- Changing other variables
- Treatment
- Interventions (brief, structured, communitybased, self-help)



## Behind Gender Based Violence

## Structural intervention

- 1% tax increase IPV lowered with 5%
- 72 beers per month 58% less police calls
- Outlet density binge drinking couples
- 1 off premise outlet 3% more IPV related crime reports



Behind Gender Based Violence

## Expectations

- Cultural scripts
- Biological proof is lacking (depressant, inhibitor)
- Unfair privileges









- Integration of already existing actions
- Simple and low cost
- Local actions for global impact




## Analysis of structural interventions
